# Slopes and Erosion Control

Slopes offer opportunities for effective plant presentation, though they may create challenges as well. The following group of plants works well on slopes. Some have the added benefit of helping to slow runoff in the rain.

Plants that help prevent the erosion of soil by setting solid, spreading roots or by growing water shedding foliage provide soil stability. These double-duty plants are not only aesthetically pleasing, but also provide peace of mind.

Please note the \*\* by plants that not only work on slopes, but also hold the soil.
