Plants that grow here naturally are adapted to local conditions. Caution: we live in an area with a lot of variation in local conditions! The local conditions they are native to are specific. If you're looking for plants that are naturally selected to do well in your garden, investigate where specific "native" plants are found naturally, and try to get them into a similar situation.

Another bit of advice: a garden with all natives is often not the most ornamental of landscapes; there are many natural looking companions to these natives that can punch up the look without looking out of place.
