



Agapanthus 'Cobalt Blue'

African Lily (Code: 7464)

Cobalt-blue globe-like umbels appear on 2' stalks above strap-like leaves in summer. An excellent choice for adding an exotic touch to containers or the garden. (24" x 12-24") Zn8.



Agastache 'Cotton Candy'

Hyssop (Code: 6625)

Light pink flower spikes bloom from midsummer to fall! Compact habit, drought tolerant and very attractive to hummingbirds. Requires good drainage. (18-24" x 18") Zn6. PP20991, PVR Propagation Prohibited.



Agastache 'Raspberry Summer'

Hyssop (Code: 6626)

Large, dark raspberry-pink flowers bloom all summer and into fall! Attractive, bright green foliage is nicely fragrant and drought tolerant. Requires good drainage. (30" x 20") Zn6. PP20371, PVR Propagation Prohibited.



Agastache 'Summer Glow'

Hyssop (Code: 6627)

Pale yellow flowers with dark calyces bloom all summer. Has a narrow upright habit with bright green foliage that is drought tolerant. Requires good drainage. (18-24" x 18") Zn6. PP20980, PVR Propagation Prohibited.



Ajuga reptans 'Blueberry Muffin'

Carpet Bugle (Code: 7393)


Blueberry-blue blooms on 8" spikes shine above small-leaved foliage in spring. Faster and stronger growing than A. 'Chocolate Chip', this vigorous groundcover is weather resistant as well. (5-6" x 24-30") Zn4. PPAF, PVR Propagation Prohibited



Ajuga reptans 'Sparkler'

Bugleweed (Code: 7436)

The dark green, shiny foliage is covered in creamy-white splashes that turn pink in winter. The most vigorous, variegated Ajuga, it's awesome as an accent in containers, or as a ground-cover. Lovely blue flowers appear late spring. (3-4" x 12-18") Zn6. PPAF



Athyrum filix-femina 'Frizelliae'

Tattling Fern (Code: 7688)

This distinctive fern has deep green fronds that resemble necklaces. Delicate looking, but adaptable as any lady fern. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12-18" x 12-18") Zn3.



Athyrum filix-femina x niponicum 'Branford Rambler'

Running Lady Fern (Code: 4963)

This vigorous, spreading deciduous groundcover fern has purplish-red stems and short green fronds. Dependable and adaptable in shady locations, but never invasive. (18-24" x 24-36") Zn4.



Bouteloua gracilis 'Blonde Ambition'

Blue Gramma, Mosquito Grass (Code: 7804)

The brush-like flowers rise up out of the blue-green foliage in mid-summer and are suspended horizontally for months on stiff, weather-resistant stems. The flowers turn chartreuse by fall and then mature to long-lasting blonde seed heads. Larger-growing than the native Blue Gramma. (24-36" x 24-36") Zn4. PPAF



Calamintha cretica

Calamint (Code: 6484)

A groundcover that has wide, fuzzy gray-green leaves and light pink/mauve flowers that bloom in mid-summer. Before it flowers it is sometimes confused with Dittany of Crete. (3-5" x 18-24") Zn6.



Calibrachoa 'MBÂ® Brilliant Pink'

Million Bells, Mini Petunia (Code: 7783)

The original Million Bells and still the best seller! This compact, low grower has fine foliage and 1&euro, trumpet-shaped brilliant pink blooms that open nonstop until hard frost without need of deadheading. A Hummingbird favorite! (12-15" x 15-20") Zn9.



Calibrachoa 'MBÂ® Crackling Fire'

Million Bells Mini Petunia (Code: 7780)

The original Million Bells and still the best seller! This compact, low grower has fine foliage and 1&euro, trumpet-shaped orange and yellow striped blooms that open nonstop until hard frost without need of deadheading. A Hummingbird favorite! (6-10" x 7-8") Zn9.



Calibrachoa 'MBÂ® Neon Yellow'

Million Bells, Mini Petunia (Code: 7786)

The original Million Bells and still the best seller! This compact, low grower has fine foliage and 1&euro, trumpet-shaped neon yellow blooms that open nonstop until hard frost without need of deadheading. A Hummingbird favorite! (8-10" x 10") Zn9.



Calibrachoa 'MiniFamous™ Double Pink'

Mini-Petunia (Code: 4523)

Luscious clear pink rosettes cover this fantastic new selection of Calibrachoa. It combines well with all colors and is a great choice for mixed containers and hanging baskets. A no maintenance beauty! (1-3" x 12-18") Zn9.

Calibrachoa 'Perfect Red'

Mini-Petunia (Code: 5211)

Deep red flowers bloom nonstop spring through fall! Trailing habit perfect for baskets, containers or groundcovers. Self-cleaning and easy to grow. (4-6" x 12") Zn9.



Calibrachoa Mini Famous™ 'Pink Dark Eye'

Mini Petunia (Code: 7571)

Pretty pink flowers with a dark center bloom nonstop! This heat tolerant trailing form is perfect for spilling out of baskets & mixed containers. (4" x 18-24") Zn9.



Coleus (Solenostemon) 'Beckwith's Gem'

Coleus (Code: 4592)

A dramatic heirloom Coleus with leaves that have a wide light yellow border which surrounds a center flame of red and dark purple. Leaf color will be greener in shade. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn10.



Coprosma 'Middlemore'

Mirror Plant (Code: 7702)

A versatile evergreen shrub with small glossy green leaves. Excellent in containers where a dark green color is desired. Likes full sun, will tolerate light frost and coastal conditions. (3' x 3') Zn9.



Coprosma 'Pina Colada'

Mirror Plant (Code: 7703)

Glossy, golden leaves turn to shades of orange when nights cool down. This tender evergreen shrub is fast-growing and deer-resistant and does best in fertile, well-drained soil. Pina Colada's shiny, colorful foliage will brighten any container. (3' x 3') Zn9.



Coprosma 'Tequila Sunrise'

Mirror Plant (Code: 7704)

Brightly colored, jewel-like, glossy foliage emerges emerald green with a gold margin in spring, and gradually becomes marbled with brilliant orange and gold hues. In cool weather, the leaf color intensifies to brilliant orange and red jewel tones. Fantastic in containers! (3' x 3') Zn9. PP18392



Coreopsis 'Cherry Lemonade'

Tickseed (Code: 7686)

Bright, feathery golden foliage is topped by clear red flowers that bloom all summer! Grows easily as a low mound. Great accent in containers! (8-10" x 12-15") Zn9. PP18334 EU25408



Coreopsis 'Citrine'

Tickseed (Code: 7632)

Masses of yellow daisies appear all summer long! The bright yellow petals surround a golden orange disk, attracting butterflies and bees. It forms a compact mound. (12" x 16-20") Zn7. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



Coreopsis 'Cranberry Ice'

Tickseed (Code: 7678)

Cranberry colored flowers have a white edge and bloom continuously all summer. Lovely, informal mounding habit, lends itself to containers or beds. Stays compact. (8-10" x 15-20") Zn6. PP19470 EU-derived var



Coreopsis 'Garnet'

Tickseed (Code: 7631)

Bright garnet-red colored flowers bloom profusely from June to October. With a compact habit, it is well suited both for containers and landscape. (12" x 16-20") Zn7. PPAF



Coreopsis 'Ruby Frost'

Tickseed (Code: 7394)

A color breakthrough! Stunning red blooms have a white edge and bloom all summer over rich green foliage. Easy to grow and a marvelous addition to the mixed border. (12-18" x 12-16") Zn6. PPAF, PVR Propagation Prohibited



Coreopsis tripteris 'Flower Tower'

Tall Coreopsis (Code: 7665)

This improvement on the native species sets hundreds of 2 1/2- to 3-inch daisies of bright yellow-gold. They appear in gigantic bouquets atop straight stems and tall, dense foliage, beginning in late summer and continuing through early fall. Finches love the seeds in winter! (6-10' x 3-5') Zn3.



Cosmos atrosanguineus

Chocolate Cosmos (Code: 2449)

Deep maroon flowers with a chocolate scent bloom profusely all summer! The flowers are held on long wiry stems and are wonderful in flower arrangements. Very late to emerge in the spring, but worth the wait. (18-30" x 18") Zn7.



Cotinus coggygia 'Daydream'

Smoke Tree (Code: 7466)

One of the best selections with green foliage because it's such a heavy bloomer. The pink flowers are very full and fluffy. Has a more compact habit than other varieties. (8-10' x 8-10') Zn5.





Dahlia 'Mystic Beauty'

Dahlia (Code: 7738)

This lovely single Dahlia has orchid-pink petals that curl delicately inwards at the edges to reveal a paler reverse. The eye of the flower is bright yellow, creating a splendid display in summer. (24-28" x 24") Zn9. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



Dahlia 'Mystic Haze'

Dahlia (Code: 7830)

Glossy mahogany-black foliage bursting with apricot to orange blooms that have soft yellow halos with a dark central eye. Compact rounded form and is a butterfly magnet! (24-31" x 20-24") Zn9. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



Dianthus 'Devon Cottage', Miss Pinky'

Pinks (Code: 7696)

Large, double salmon-pink blooms are delightful as cut flowers. The plant has a compact habit with grass-like blue-green leaves and blooms continuously throughout the summer when deadheaded. Wonderful as a border plant, in rock gardens, or for edging walks. (10-14" x 12-16") Zn4. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



Dicentra 'Ivory Hearts'

Fringed Bleeding Heart (Code: 4583)

Creamy-white bleeding hearts bloom May to September above gray-green, fern-like foliage. (10-12" x 12-15") Zn4. PP15599 Propagation prohibited.



Dicentra x hybrida 'Candy Hearts'

Bleeding Heart (Code: 4086)

Silver-blue, lacy fern-like foliage has masses of cotton-candy-pink flowers appearing mid-spring 'til fall. It has an excellent compact form. (10" x 12") Zn3. PP14692 Propagation Prohibited.



Echinacea 'Hot Lava'

Coneflower (Code: 7451)

Resembles a flaming pool of magma! Wide petals of deep orange-red turn to a deeper red at the base of the dark orange cone. Extra petals give the flowers a fuller look and the super-strong stems make it a natural for cut flowers. (32" x 24-32") Zn4. PPAF



Echinacea 'Solar Flare'

Coneflower (Code: 7590)

The flowers burst forth with fiery orange-red petals that surround a dark cone. The fragrant blooms appear from mid to late summer. (30-36" x 24-30") Zn5. PPAF



Echinacea 'Tangerine Dream'

Coneflower (Code: 7680)

Elegant clear tangerine-orange flowers have wide, overlapping petals. The flowers hold their color very well and have a lovely honey scent. The multi-branching strong stems are super for the landscape, whether used en masse or in a mixed planting. Great for cutting. (18-24" x 24-30") Zn4. PPAF



Echinacea purpurea 'White Nathalie'

Coneflower (Code: 7472)

Short, thick green stems are topped by pure white flowers, with overlapping petals and orange-brown centers. A long bloomer, producing many flowering stems. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn4.



Epimedium 'Purple Pixie'

Bishop's Hat (Code: 7660)

The flowers have vivid, violet-purple sepals with protruding pure white spurs. The foliage is tight and dense with handsome rhubarb-red markings in spring. This is a compact, yet vigorous, clump-forming Epimedium that looks best when planted in groups. (9-12" x 15-24") Zn5. PP13966



Epimedium x versicolor 'Cupreum'

Barrenwort (Code: 7689)

Dainty copper-red flowers top brownish-red foliage in spring. The foliage ages to mid-green by late spring. Tolerates dry shade. (7-12" x 12-15") Zn5.



Eriogonum umbellatum ssp. polyanthum var. subalpinum

Sulfur Flower, Buckwheat (Code: 5918)

Umbels of yellow flowers age to orange-red and persist for weeks in late spring and early summer. The gray-green spoon-shaped leaves form a low mound. Requires gravelly soil. This species is found in the mountains of Southern Oregon and Northern California. (8-12" x 15-24") Zn3.



Erysimum 'Fragrant Star'

Wallflower (Code: 7614)

Sweetly scented yellow blooms are complemented with leaves that have creamy-yellow margins. Being sterile, flowering may continue to October! Chocolate-purple flower buds make a dramatic contrast to the flowers and foliage. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn7. PPAF



Eupatorium dubium 'Baby Joe'

Joe-pye (Code: 7651)

This dwarf form of Joe-pye stays just 30" tall! Cabernet-colored flowers appear in late summer and are a magnet for butterflies. Prefer moist soils. (24-30" x 18-24") Zn4.





Euphorbia 'Silver Fog'

Spurge (Code: 7848)

Tiny, delicate, frilly white blooms surround the compact mid-green foliage giving it an ethereal appearance summer through fall. Great in hanging baskets and no dead-heading needed! (10-12" x 10-12") Zn9.



Hebe pimeleoides ssp. pimeleoides (var. minor)

Hebe (Code: 4361)

This is a low, spreading Hebe just 6" tall with small blue-gray evergreen leaves. Lavender-purple flowers bloom at the ends of its black stems in summer. An excellent choice for the rock garden. (6" x 12") Zn7.



Helleborus niger 'HGC Jacob'

Christmas Rose (Code: 7612)

Shimmering pure white, upright flowers appear from late fall through the winter in mild climates. In cold climates, flowers bloom in early spring. The dark evergreen foliage provides a dramatic contrast to the flowers and forms a compact mound. One of the Helleborus Gold Collection (HGC). Requires well-drained soils. (8-12" x 12-15") Zn3. PP 17799



Helleborus niger 'HGC Josef Lemper'

Christmas Rose (Code: 7611)

This improved form of Helleborus niger was selected for its upright habit and longer flowering period. Large white flowers appear from October through February in mild climates. In cold climates, flowers appear in early spring. One of the Helleborus Gold Collection (HGC). Requires well-drained soils. (8-10" x 12-18") Zn3. PP15615



Hemerocallis 'Rosy Returns'

Daylily (Code: 3974)

This daylily blooms continuously all season! Large rose-pink flowers have deep rose eyezones and bright-yellow throats. Vigorous and easy to grow! (15-18" x 18") Zn3. PP9779 Propagation Prohibited.



Heuchera 'Blackberry Crisp'

Coral Bells (Code: 7654)

The ruffled purple foliage has distinctly crinkled and crisped margins. It has a tight mounding habit with leaves that change from deep burgundy in the spring to deep purple-black in summer. Short white flowers in spring add to this appealing gem. (8-15" x 12-16") Zn4. PPAF, PVR



Heuchera 'Cherry Cola'

Coral Bells (Code: 7698)

Rich chocolate-cherry leaves are topped by glowing vermilion-red flowers in late spring. The foliage color sparkles year round. (8-16" x 12-15") Zn4. PPAF, PVR



Heuchera 'Fire Chief'

Coral Bells (Code: 7417)

Lustrous wine-red leaves glow on this mid-sized Heuchera. Small bicolored pink and white flowers appear on dark red stems from spring through fall. (8-10" x 12-16") Zn4. PPAF, PVR Propagation Prohibited



Heuchera 'Lipstick'

(Code: 7454)

Silver-veiled green leaves give rise to bright lipstick-red flowers. Many Heucheras feature foliage color, but the re-blooming flowers are the main attraction of this cultivar. An excellent choice for naturalistic landscapes. (7-15" x 10-12") Zn4. PPAF, PVR



Heucherella 'Brass Lanterns'

Foamy Bells (Code: 7675)

The maple-shaped leaves are a beacon of brassy gold and red in spring. In summer the leaves are reddish-brown. In winter the evergreen leaves turn olive and brown. The best color contrast occurs with some shade. Spikes of white flowers on dark stems appear in spring. (24-28" x 24-28") Zn4. PPAF, PVR



Heucherella 'Golden Zebra'

Foamy Bells (Code: 7400)

Feathery, bright yellow leaves are vividly detailed with broad red-purple margins. Fabulous foliage and a compact habit makes it a fabulous groundcover or underplanting in the garden. (10-14" x 12") Zn4. PPAF, PVR Propagation Prohibited



Hosta 'Blue Angel'

Plantain Lily (Code: 7641)

One of the largest Hostas around! The heart-shaped, heavily textured, ribbed, blue-gray leaves can be up to 18" across! White flowers appear in mid summer. (2-3' x 4-5") Zn3.



Hosta 'Great Expectations'

Plantain Lily (Code: 7386)

Bright creamy yellow puckered leaves boast extremely wide margins of blue-green. Pristine white flowers add interest in early summer. (24-36" x 40") Zn3.



Hosta 'Loyalist'

Plantain Lily (Code: 7639)

One of the best white centered hostas to arrive on the gardening scene. It is a reverse variegated form of H. 'Patriot'. Light lavender flowers appear in summer. Very striking! (20-24" x 20-24") Zn3.





Hosta 'Paradise Island'

Plantain Lily (Code: 7640)

Heart-shaped bright yellow leaves have a dark green margin. In summer, the brilliant yellow leaf interior changes to chartreuse, but the dark border remains. Lavender flowers top the clump in late summer. This beautiful 'Fire Island' sport is one of the best! (18-24" x 18-24") Zn3. PPAF



Ipomoea 'Sidekick& Black Heart'

Sweet Potato Vine (Code: 7842)

Striking heart shaped purple-black leaves with a matte finish will add rich texture and contrast to any container or border. A compact yet bushy variety. (12-14" x 30-46") Zn10.



Ipomoea batatas 'Desana& Bronze'

Sweet Potato Vine (Code: 7787)

Heart-shaped bronze leaves have shorter internodes than other Ipomoea cultivars, giving a more compact growth habit. Excellent for planters and baskets. (8-12" x 24-36") Zn10.



Ipomoea batatas 'Goldfinger'

Sweet Potato Vine (Code: 7046)

Chartreuse-gold leaves are deeply divided. This fast growing, spreading plant is perfect as an annual groundcover or for use in hanging baskets. (4-5" x 18-36") Zn10.



Koeleria 'Tiny Tot'

Blue Hair Grass (Code: 7659)

This dwarf ornamental grass has distinctly blue-green fine-textured foliage that's topped by narrow erect flower panicles in late spring. The inflorescences open light green and then age to a pleasing buff color. Excellent when used as a filler in mixed containers. (8-10" x 8-12") Zn5.



Lamium maculatum 'Ghost'

Deadnettle (Code: 7662)

Standing about 1 foot tall, the all-silver leaves create a billowy cloud of silver in the garden. The leaves are twice as big as most Lamium. Clusters of large, bright orchid-purple flowers top the clump of silver foliage from late spring through early summer. The contrast of flowers and foliage stops people in their tracks! (10-14" x 12-24") Zn4.



Ligularia dentata 'Osiris Fantaisie'

Golden Ray (Code: 7638)

The thick, dark-green leaves have serrated edges which curl over to reveal glossy, burgundy undersides. Deep purple-red stems rise in late summer holding clusters of golden-yellow daisy-like flowers. Plants have a good, full habit and make an attractive focal point. (12-20" x 18-24") Zn4. PP19302



Iberis 'Snow Cushion'

Candytuft (Code: 7695)

This dwarf form of candytuft has showy, white blossoms in spring. It has a low spreading form with glossy, fine textured evergreen foliage that is deep green in color. Highly recommended for rock gardens! (4-6" x 12-18") Zn3.



Ipomoea batatas 'Ace of Spades'

Sweet Potato Vine (Code: 7045)

Broad, heart-shaped leaves are deep garnet-purple. The vigorous growth makes it perfect as an annual groundcover or in hanging baskets. (4-5" x 18-36") Zn10.



Ipomoea batatas 'Desana& Lime'

Sweet Potato Vine (Code: 7788)

Heart-shaped chartreuse leaves have shorter internodes than other Ipomoea cultivars, giving a more compact growth habit. Excellent for planters and baskets. (8-12" x 24-36") Zn10.



Juncus patens

Common Rush (Code: 7832)

Green, graceful knee-high arching foliage with brown flowers then seed heads from May to Nov. Loves wet feet but can tolerate dry to drought conditions once established. Native from WA to CA. (2-3' x 2-3') Zn6.



Lamium 'Lemon Frost'

Deadnettle (Code: 7593)

Deep lavender-pink flowers top chartreuse, heart-shaped leaves in late spring and summer. It creates a bold contrast in shady areas where bright color is often needed. (6-8" x 12-18") Zn4. PP20723



Leucanthemum x superbum 'Victorian Secret'

Shasta Daisy (Code: 7705)

Long-lasting, semi-double ruffled daisies appear in summer. The flowers wear well, even through extreme heat! The compact habit requires no staking. Flowers are odor-free, (a good thing in daisies). (12-15" x 18-24") Zn5. PPAF, PVR



Lobelia 'Techno Heat& Upright Light Blue'

Lobelia (Code: 7850)

Mounds of white starry flowers with subtle tints of blue on the petals makes this a perfect choice to brighten your garden. Bred to be heat tolerant while blooming non-stop this series is a winner! (6-12" x 12-18") Zn9.





Lonicera involucrata

Black Twinberry (Code: 7268)

Pairs of small, yellow, pendulous, tubular flowers are surrounded by green bracts in late spring and summer. After the flowers fade, pairs of showy black berries form, each surrounded by the bracts that have now turned bright red. The flowers of this handsome shrub are enjoyed by hummingbirds, while other birds and wildlife will eat the berries. A Pacific Northwest native. (8-10' x 6-8') Zn4.



Lonicera periclymenum 'Peaches and Cream'

Honeysuckle (Code: 7797)

Fragrant, summer-blooming vine makes a gorgeous display of creamy yellow and soft pink flowers. Attracts hummingbirds. Evergreen in mild climates. (5-6' x 1.5-2.5') Zn4. PPAF



Oenothera fremontii 'Shimmer'

Evening Primrose (Code: 7694)

Bright lemon-yellow saucer-like blooms appear in spring, then bloom again mid summer and fall! The fine textured silver and green variegated foliage is showy even when not in flower. Compact habit. (10" x 18") Zn4. PP19663 COPF



Paeonia Itoh 'Sequestered Sunshine'

Itoh Peony (Code: 7683)

Large, bright canary-yellow blossoms with showy stamens stand above the lush, dark green, deeply dissected foliage. An especially vigorous plant, the sturdy flower stems require no staking and make good cut flowers. (36-42" x 36-42") Zn3.



Paeonia Itoh 'Visions of Sugar Plums'

Itoh Peony (Code: 7684)

The large, single flowers are soft pink blending to a deeper pink at the petal edge. Each petal has huge plum-colored flares towards the center. It forms a bushy shrub-like plant that is very long-lived. Fabulous in late spring when in bloom! (3' x 3') Zn3.



Panicum 'Huron Solstice'

Switchgrass (Code: 7637)

The blue-green foliage begins turning a deep burgundy-wine color in early summer, and by fall is almost totally burgundy, providing a stunning accent with its blazing fall color. Dainty, airy, purplish inflorescences appear atop the foliage in late August. (48" x 36") Zn4. PPAF



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Burgundy Bunny'

Fountain Grass (Code: 7687)

Clumps of fine leaves start green in spring, then have red accents in summer, topped with creamy white bunny-tail flowers. In autumn, the foliage color deepens until the entire plant is glowing red! (10-12" x 12-15") Zn6. PPAF



Pennisetum setaceum 'Skyrocket'

Fountain Grass (Code: 7594)

Bright green & pristine white variegated foliage explodes with pink plumes in summer. A sport of P. 'Fireworks'. Highly recommended for containers! (24-30" x 18-24") Zn9. PPAF



Penstemon procerus var. brachanthus

Pincushion Penstemon (Code: 7711)

This charming, mat-forming Penstemon has spikes of small purple flowers to 10" tall in late spring. Native from northern California through Oregon. (3-10" x 18-24") Zn6.



Petunia 'Littletonia' White Grace'

Petunia (Code: 7844)

A compact mound of continuous pure white 1-1/2" blooms from late spring to fall making this Grace truly amazing! Self cleaning so no need for deadheading. Fertilize weekly for best performance. (4-6" x 18-24") Zn10.



Polygonatum biflorum 'Prince Charming'

Soloman's Seal (Code: 7260)

Arching stems of blue-green leaves no taller than 12" start the spring with many pairs of creamy white flowers. In fall purple berries are followed by golden yellow fall color. Can tolerate full sun with moist, well-drained soil but prefers part shade. (8-12" x 24-36") Zn3. PPAF



Rudbeckia hirta 'Denver Daisy', 'c'

Black-eyed Susan (Code: 7852)

Named for the Mile High City, this daisy sports giant 8" flowers of the purest yellow the a deep, rusty-red radiating up the petal creating a halo effect around the chocolate brown cone. Selected for it's heat tolerance, summer long flower power and its ability to stand up to extreme conditions, it was used by Denver for their 150th anniversary city beautification project. (22-26" x 18-20") Zn3.





Rudbeckia hirta 'Prairie Sun'

Gloriosa Daisy, Black-eyed Susan (Code: 7853)

Best when treated as an annual, this Rudbeckia has 5" flowers featuring light orange rays tipped with lemon yellow all surrounding a greenish center disk. Robust, free-flowering and heat tolerant. (30-36" x 18-24") Zn3.



Sambucus nigra ssp. caerulea

Blue Elderberry (Code: 7239)

NW native deciduous shrub with pinnate compound leaves and creamy-white, flat-topped flowers 6" in width that bloom from late spring to early summer. Dark blue berries follow in summer and fall and are often made into jams. (12-20' x 8-12') Zn4.



Santolina 'Lemon Fizz'

Lavender Cotton (Code: 7646)

Spicy scented chartreuse foliage is accented by creamy yellow flowers that resemble tiny buttons. It forms a low mound of evergreen foliage. Prefers well-drained soils. (12-15" x 12-18") Zn6. PPAF



Scabiosa atropurpurea 'Beaujolais Bonnet'

Pincushion Flower (Code: 7693)

Rich burgundy flowers with contrasting paler outer petals and white stamens appear for months on long wiry stems, perfect for cut flowers. Ideal for attracting butterflies to your borders or containers. (20-24" x 18-24") Zn.



Sedum 'Beach Party'

Stonecrop (Code: 7603)

Sedum 'Beach Party'™ is blanketed with thousands of star shaped, light rose-pink flowers that look like mounding dunes. Bees and butterflies will definitely have a party feasting on the prolific blooms. (14-18" x 18-24") Zn4. PPAF, PVR



Sedum 'Chocolate Drop'

Stonecrop (Code: 7411)

Lightly scalloped, chocolate foliage creates an eye-catching background to soft rose colored flowers in midsummer. Develops into small mounds making it a great addition to the rock garden and when mixed with bronze or yellow foliage. (10-12" x 12-15") Zn4. PPAF,PVR Propagation Prohibited



Sedum anglicum 'Love's Triangle'

Stonecrop (Code: 7700)

Mats of tiny, powder blue leaves are topped by single, pale pink bloom in late spring and early summer. An excellent plant for the rock garden, alpine trough or between stepping stones. (1-2" x 6-12") Zn3.



Sedum hakonense 'Chocolate Ball'

Stonecrop (Code: 7462)

Needle-like, succulent foliage ranges in color from milk-chocolate brown in the spring to dazzling red in the fall. Yellow flowers appear in summer. (4-6" x 12-16") Zn7.



Sedum nevii 'Pink Form'

Stonecrop (Code: 7699)

Tiny, blue-green, succulent leaves form evergreen rosettes with starry light pink flowers with purple anthers on 4 inch stalks. Although delicate in appearance, it's really quite tough if given very good drainage and sun. (2-3" x 6-12") Zn4.



Sedum spectabilis 'Pink Chablis'

Stonecrop (Code: 6015)

This variegated form of Sedum 'Brilliant' has vigorous growth with an improved compact habit. Broad green succulent leaves have a clean white edge that is well displayed. Pink flowers appear in late summer from white buds. (18" x 18-24") Zn3. PP19060 Propagation Prohibited.



Sedum x 'Thundercloud'

Stonecrop (Code: 4865)

Cloudy gray-green succulent foliage forms a compact mound. White flowers bloom in September and make a bold contrast against the foliage. (12-15" x 12-16") Zn3.



Sorbaria sorbifolia

False Spirea (Code: 7636)

This deciduous shrub forms large masses of arching branches that are covered with green compound leaves. Billowy white sprays of flowers appear in mid- to late summer. Mature plants spread where you let them. (5-8' x 8-12') Zn2.



Thymus longicaulis

Creeping Thyme (Code: 7716)

This spreading evergreen carpet of foliage has pink flowers in summer. Small pine scented leaves can be used to flavor meats. (3-5" x 18-24") Zn5.



Tiarella 'Happy Trails'

Foamy Bells (Code: 7414)

Small, rounded, lobed green leaves have marvelous black central markings making this vigorous groundcover perfect for the shade garden. Short spikes of white flowers appear midsummer. Use for cascading on a slope or mixed in containers. (4-6" x 32-36") Zn4. PPAF,PVR Propagation Prohibited





Tradescantia 'Blushing Bride'

Spiderwort (Code: 4579)

This trailing perennial is excellent for containers with leaves that are variegated pink, fading to white. The foliage color is best in winter and spring. Cut back often to encourage colorful new growth. Pink flowers appear in summer. (3-4" x 48") Zn8.



Verbena 'Rapunzel Lilac'

Verbena (Code: 7846)

Large clusters of self cleaning lilac-purple blooms on this semi-trailing variety of Verbena. Prize pick for hanging baskets, containers or sunny borders. (5-10" x 8-12") Zn10.



Verbena 'Lanai Light Blue 09'

Verbena (Code: 7851)

Large clusters of sky blue flowers with improved color and size over the original, hence the '09'. This Verbena is heat tolerant and powdery mildew resistant! A must for any container. (8-10" x 8-12") Zn10.



Yucca gloriosa var. recurvifolia 'Bright Star'

Adam's Needle (Code: 6012)

Tri-colored, sword-like, evergreen foliage forms a rosette in shades of ivory, pink and green. Lavender flowers rise above the drought tolerant blades in summer. (36" x 36") Zn7. PP17653 Propagation Prohibited.



Yucca rostrata 'Sapphire Skies'

Yucca (Code: 7630)

Stunning, long, powder-blue leaves quickly grow into a three-by-four-foot mound. With some age it will begin rising on a stout trunk to a height of four feet or more. At maturity, spectacular spires of ivory flowers appear in summer. The foliage is greener when young. Requires excellent drainage. (4-6' x 4-6') Zn6.
